Architectural Transformation of Dionysou Street: An Urban Experience Corridor

PROJECT SUMMARY

- Conducted a comprehensive analysis of Dionysou Street, examining land use, mobility, public space, vegetation, and urban infrastructure.
- Developed an urban design concept to transform the street into a walkable, people-centered corridor through thematic public spaces and improved pedestrian experience.
- Combined field research, citizen surveys, vegetation mapping, and international best practices to support evidence-based design proposals.
- Proposed sustainable interventions to improve accessibility, public life, climate resilience, and the overall quality of the urban environment.

KEY OUTCOMES

- Produced a complete urban design proposal with practical recommendations for Dionysou Street.
- Delivered vegetation mapping, community survey findings, and sustainability recommendations to support future municipal planning.
- Developed a framework of sustainability KPIs to help monitor long-term urban improvements and project impact.

LESSONS LEARNED

- Applied urban planning principles to a real municipal challenge through field research, stakeholder engagement, and data-driven analysis.
